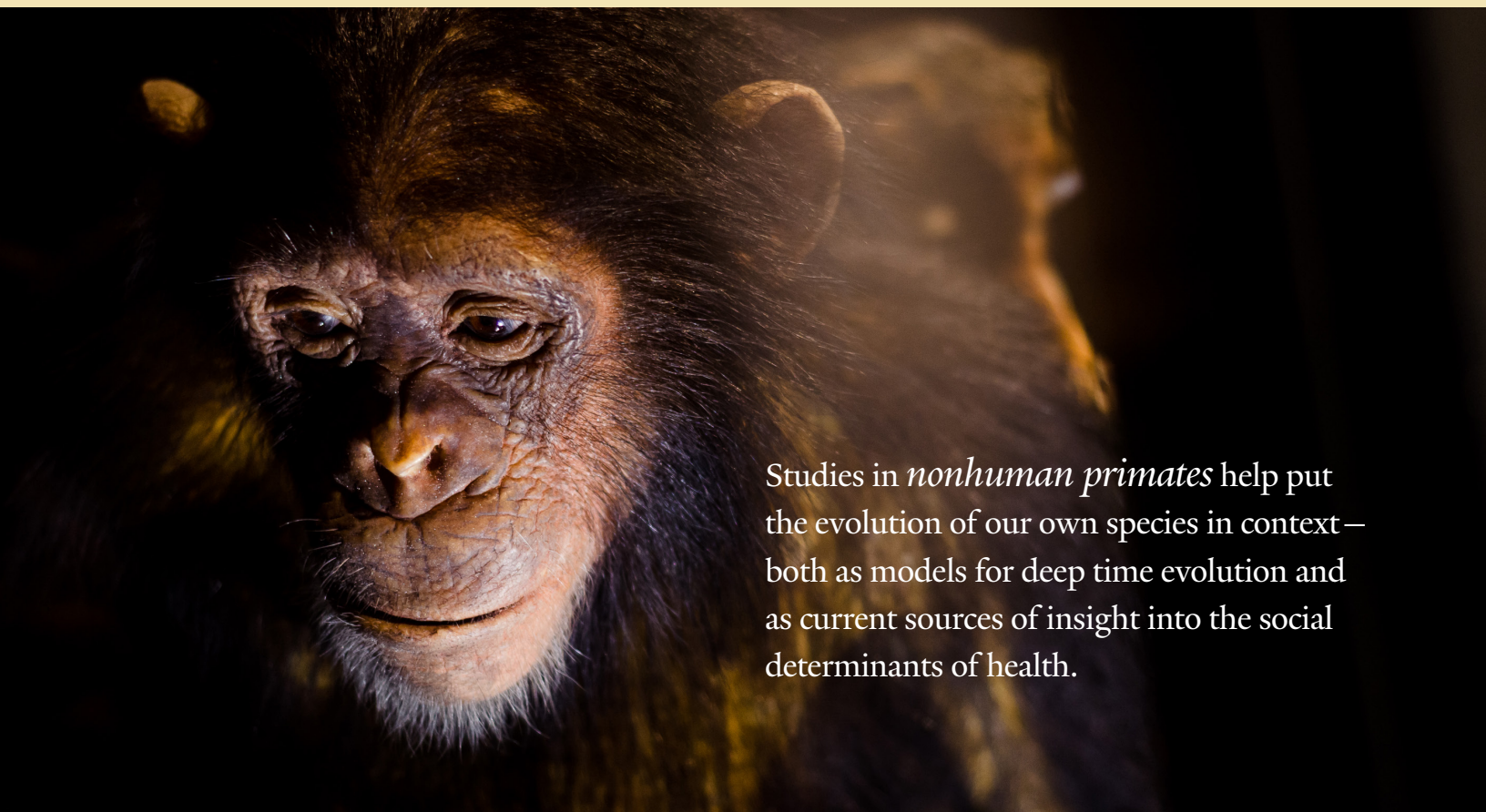


THE SOCIAL GENOME IN NONHUMAN PRIMATES
